NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the 6th Annual General Meeting of KSH HOLDINGS LIMITED will be held at 60 Eu Tong Sen Street, Furama City Centre, Ballroom 1, Level 5, Singapore 059804 on Friday, 27 July 2012 at 9.30 a.m. for the following purposes:

AS ORDINARY BUSINESS

- To receive the audited accounts for the financial year ended 31 March 2012 and the Reports of the Directors and [Resolution 1]
- 2. To declare a final tax exempt (one-tier) dividend of 0.5 cent per share for the financial year ended 31 March 2012. [Resolution 2]
- [Resolution 3] 3. To approve Directors' fees of S\$57,600 for the financial year ended 31 March 2012 to the Executive Directors. (2011: S\$57,600)
- To approve Directors' fees of S\$180,000 to be paid quarterly in arrears for the financial year ending 31 March 2013 to the Independent Directors. (2012: S\$180,000) [Resolution 4] 4
- To re-elect the following Directors who retire in accordance with Article 89 of the Company's Articles of Association
 - and who, being eligible, offer themselves for re-election :-
 - (a) Mr Kwok Ngat Khow [Resolution 5] Mr Lim Yeow Hua @ Lim You Qin [Resolution 6] (b)
 - Mr Kwok Ngat Khow will, upon re-appointment as a Director of the Company, remain as an Executive Director.
 - Mr Lim Yeow Hua @ Lim You Qin will, upon re-appointment as a Director of the Company, remain as Chairman of Audit Committee and Member of the Remuneration and Nominating Committees and will be considered independent.
- To re-appoint Ernst & Young LLP as Auditors and to authorise the Directors to fix their remuneration.

AS SPECIAL BUSINESS

To consider and, if thought fit, pass the following as Ordinary Resolutions, with or without modifications:

Authority to allot and issue shares up to 50 per centum (50%) of the total number of issued shares

[Resolution 8]

"That pursuant to Section 161 of the Companies Act, Cap. 50 and listing rules of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited, authority be and is hereby given to the directors of the Company to allot and issue shares and convertible securities in the Company (whether by way of rights, bonus or otherwise) at any time to such persons and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the directors may in their absolute discretion deem fit, provided that the aggregate number of shares and convertible securities to be issued pursuant to this resolution does not exceed 50% of the total number of issued shares excluding treasury shares issued by the Company, of which the aggregate number of shares and convertible securities to be issued other than on a pro-rata basis to existing shareholders of the Company does not exceed 20% of the total number of issued shares excluding treasury shares issued by the Company. For the purpose of this resolution, the total number of issued shares excluding treasury shares to be issued by the Company shall be based on the total number of issued shares excluding treasury shares issued by the Company at the time this resolution approving the mandate is passed (after adjusting for any new shares arising from conversion or exercise of convertible securities; or new shares arising from exercising share options or vesting of share awards outstanding or subsisting at the time of the passing of the resolution approving the mandate, provided the option or awards were granted in compliance with Part VIII of Chapter 8 of the Listing Manual and any subsequent bonus issue, consolidation or subdivision of shares in the Company), and unless revoked or varied by the Company in general meeting, such authority shall continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company or the date by which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by law to be held, whichever is the earlier."

That pursuant to Section 161 of the Companies Act, Cap. 50, the Directors be empowered to allot and issue from time to time such number of shares in the capital of the Company as may be required to be allotted and issued pursuant to the KSH Scrip Dividend Scheme.

To transact any other ordinary business of an Annual General Meeting of which due notice shall have been given.

EXPLANATORY NOTES ON SPECIAL BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED:

- Resolution 8 authorises the Directors of the Company from the date of the above Meeting until the next Annual General Meeting to issue (i) shares and convertible securities in the Company up to 50% of the Company's total number of issued shares excluding treasury shares in the capital of the Company, with an aggregate sub-limit of 20% of the Company's total number of issued shares excluding treasury shares for any issue of shares and convertible securities not made on a pro-rata basis to existing shareholders of the Company, as more particularly set out in the resolution
- Resolution 9 authorises the Directors of the Company to issue shares pursuant to the KSH Scrip Dividend Scheme to members who in respect of a qualifying dividend, have elected to receive scrip in lieu of the cash amount of qualifying dividend. (ii)
